Marking used should be a white cross on a green background
There is at least one kit on each floor of a multi-level workplace
An additional kit should be provided where there are more than 50 employees and every 50 employees thereafter
It is essential that first aid equipment be checked regularly
Items are to be replaced before the expiry date on the packets
Each work vehicle should be provided with a first aid kit



Tell-tale signs of sudden cardiac arrest

if someone is having a sudden cardiac arrest, you may see the person suddenly collapse and lose consciousness. You may also find them unconscious and unable to respond when you call or shake them. They may not be breathing, or have an abnormal breathing pattern. If you check, you usually can't find a pulse. The person's skin also may become dark or blue from lack of oxygen. The person may not move, or their movements may look like a seizure (spasms).


